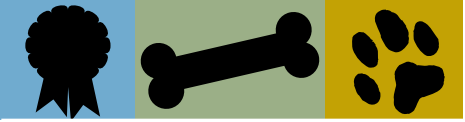

Important Information About Parking For The Five Day Cluster Of Shows.

ALL exhibitors & spectators will be required to park their vehicle in one of the two large parking lots on either side of the fairgrounds. Security personnel will be utilizing entry gates at both show ground entrances to direct traffic to the designated parking lots.

Cars with handicap signage/license plates will be allowed to park in the designated handicapped parking areas only. A limited number of handicap spaces will be available on a first-come/first-serve basis.

Exhibitors will be allowed to enter the show ring area in their cars, **only to load/unload equipment.** Cars will be required to leave the show ring areas IMMEDIATELY after you are done loading/unloading your vehicle.

JUDGES ONLY parking areas will be strictly enforced.

Exhibitors who are pre-registered for RV parking will be allowed to have ONE additional vehicle that can be parked within the spot assigned to the RV. Any additional vehicles associated with any RV will be required to park in one of the two general parking lots.

NO general parking will be allowed in any of the RV parking areas.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. 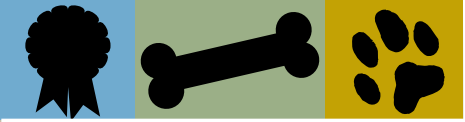

Norma Helmeke

October 27, 1920 - December 31, 2010



These Specialties are dedicated to the memory of Norma Helmeke, a long-time member of the Minnesota English Setter Club (MESC), who died in December 2010 at the age of 90.

Norma became a member of MESC in the late 1960's after her daughter, Debbie, got started in the breed. She remained a member until the time of her death – over 40 years. She served on the board and as club treasurer a number of times, as well as being the 'Donut Lady', back in the days of the first separate specialties, when complimentary donuts and coffee were the order of the day.

Norma attended many regional specialties throughout the 1970s and 1980s, as well as a number of Nationals. She attended the 2008 Eukanuba Invitational in Long Beach, Calif., to watch Debbie compete with two dogs in the agility competition. Norma always enjoyed watching the dogs in the ring as well as the social aspects of the shows and made lasting friendships from those times. Norma's last trial was Key City, last October, where she was thrilled to see her Jersey earn her MXJ.
